Innovation Lab Interns: Two student positions are currently available for the summer. Up to 40 hours per week over the course of the summer term. Housing on the Hatfield Marine Science Center campus in Newport will be provided.

DUTIES: Interns' duties are a combination of learner, designer, builder and mentor. The students will focus on the engineering and design associated with the study of the marine world, developing and building a new project idea or one proposed by the iLab Manager. The iLab Assistant will collaboratively work with other students and staff members on a variety of projects.
