










### **Ecolab Industrial Overview**

**Business Landscape and Segment Structure** 









### FAQ's

- •What is the expected salary range for interns? We pay \$25/hr for the position. They will be working approximately 40 hours a week.
- •Is there a moving stipend for positions that require moving, and if so, how much? If they are relocating more than 50 miles from their residential address, we will provide relocation support. This will be variable and dependent on location, but we give students up to a net \$5K to help with the move.
- •Do we provide visa sponsorships? We do not provide any sponsorships now or in the future. They need to have work authorization.
- •What year of school are internships available to? We are only looking for Winter 2025 and Spring 2026 grad dates for the 2025 summer internships.
